### Anonymous Donor Makes New Fishing Dock on Frontier Lake a Reality

A passion for fishing and a generous \$7,000 gift from an anonymous donor is the motivation behind the future construction of a new fishing dock at The Glenridge. Thanks to his generosity and vision and his desire to share his passion for fishing with all Glenridge Members, this enhancement to the fishing experience on Frontier Lake is a benefit that he and others will enjoy for many years to come. His dream of a dock to fish off on Frontier Lake will soon become a reality.

The new fishing dock will be built by Florida Shoreline and Foundation, a local company with expertise in constructing docks. Florida Shoreline is excited about this project and is dedicated to providing superior quality with this new addition to The Glenridge. Florida Shoreline will provide the labor, equipment, and materials necessary to construct and install the fishing dock on Frontier Lake. The dock will be 6' X 15' and will be constructed out of marine grade Trex brand composite decking with pressure treated pilings and railings. The design will be an accessible design to accommodate anyone who wishes to use it.

Permitting for this project with Sarasota County has already begun. It is anticipated that the permitting process may take a few months to complete. Once completed, construction can begin. The new dock will be built on the north end of Frontier Lake, which has been dubbed the granddaddy of all Glenridge lakes.

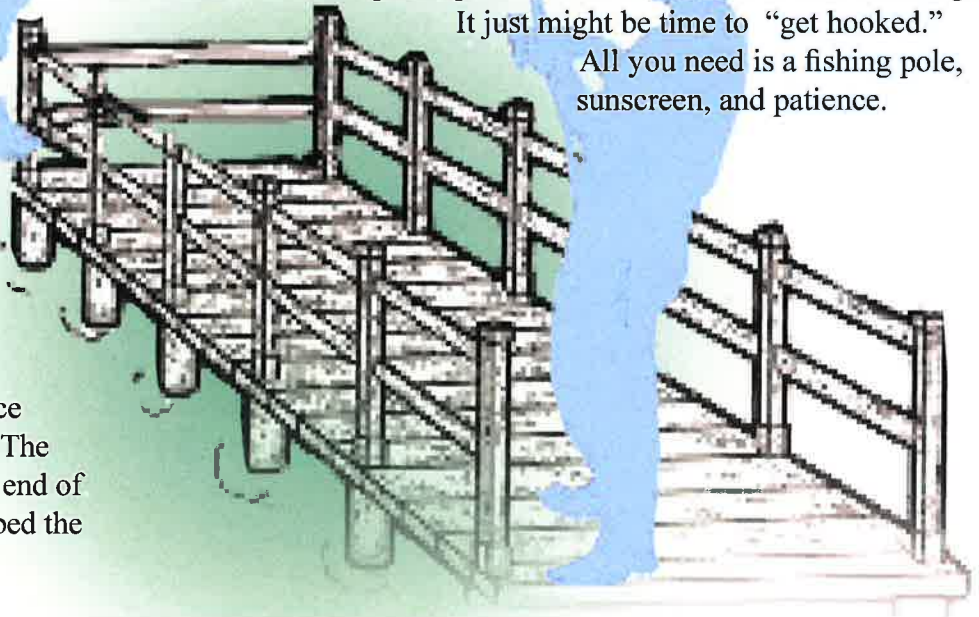

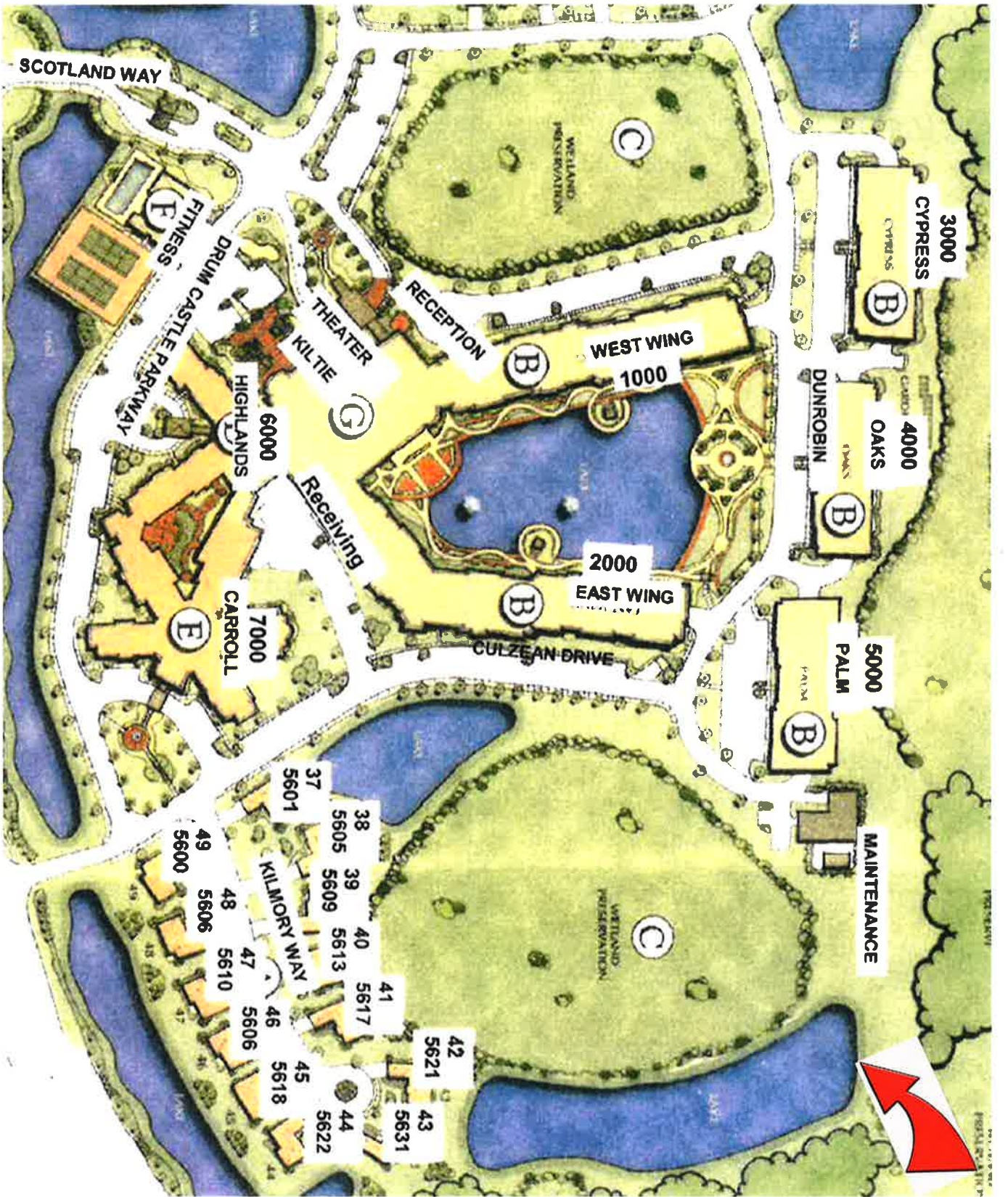
If you are an avid fisherman or a novice, the new dock might be just what you are looking for to enhance your participation in activities here at The Glenridge.
